



Museum Educator

This summer position is intended for an individual with a working background in museum (or other informal) education, teaching, and management. An academic degree in Education, Museums, History, Earth Science, Astronomy, Child Development or a related field is encouraged. The position will run for a period of up to 14 weeks May-August 2023 (exact dates dependent upon the schedule of the successful applicant). The chosen candidate will be a strong leader and collaborator and is expected to help with the preparation for the CCM's Annual Dino Shindig. Current or retired teachers are welcome to apply.

Main Duties

- Promoting, facilitating, and managing the museum's summer Junior Scientist day camp series (beginning June 1)
- Design and management of museum based-educational programming including but not limited to earth and space science content, star parties, pop-up activities, and virtual education opportunities hosted on the museum's social media channels (Facebook, Instagram, YouTube).
- Design of exhibits and kits that utilize teaching collections from the museum
- Management of volunteers and associated kids activities for the Annual Dino Shindig (July 22-23, 2023)
- Other activities dependent on dates.

Note: All curricula, activities and associated programming are subject to the approval of the Executive Director.

Additional Duties

- Organizing and facilitating activities for school and group tours, as needed
- Community engagement
- Answering visitor questions
- Workshop co-facilitation with museum director and associates

Compensation

Seasonal positions will be paid \$15.00 per hour at 40 hours/week for up to 14 weeks. Accepted applicants will be provided lodging if necessary. College credits (if applicable) may be awarded if an agreement is reached between the CCM and the applicant's university.

Application Requirements:

Educational program proposal (1-2 pages), resume, one-page statement of interest, cover letter and two professional or academic letters of recommendation.
